



July 14, 2024 Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

"Jesus... began to send them out two-by-two." These words from today's Gospel (see Mark 6:7-13) tell us about the beginnings of apostolic ministry in the Church. What Jesus began on that day he continues to do in and through the Church even today. He summons you and sends you out to accomplish his will.

St. Paul reminds us (see Ephesians 1:3~14) that "In him we were also chosen." Just as he chose his Twelve, so too does Jesus "choose" you. In his love he reveals to you the reality of the spiritual blessings God lavishes on the world, changing us in the depth of our being to become holy in his sight. He sends you out to others to help them to perceive and to understand this same saving love. Just as you have been changed and raised up in the power of Jesus' love, so too are you to help the world see what a great power of mercy and love changes our world for the better and raises us up in a love higher than all others.

Jesus sent the apostles out "two-by-two." He sends you out in the same way. Who is your apostolic buddy?? Do you have one? Do you know who it is? First, and foremost, we always go forth "two-by-two" because we are never alone in his work or life: we have Jesus our brother at our side. Jesus never asks us to do anything he himself has not already accomplished before us. He never asks us to be alone, for he always accompanies us in the task of making God better known and loved. Especially in moments when you might feel most alone, most out there with no protection or welcome, most isolate, Jesus asks you to remember that he is with you to sustain and to deliver you. You are not alone, especially in those moments of life that are the most trying and, from the world's point of view, most hopeless. He is there with you. Among the friendships you enjoy in life, there should be a truly "spiritual friend" who has a place in your heart.

The theme of "two-by-two" is important with regard to the reality that we are called to share with others. We bear the word of life. You and I are not sent merely to inform or point to some idea or to convince people of some truth or other. We are sent to help people perceive the presence of a "greater" love at the center of life, a love that can only be appreciated and known together, in community. We bear the word of God's kindness and love. It is not so much a word to be imparted. It is, rather, an ongoing conversation into which we invite others to enter and in which to come to a new appreciation of life and of love.

Our mission in the Gospel is not merely "to" someone. It is always already "with" them and "for" them because it is always preceded by the very love of God who moves them first.

I am grateful to those who planned and served last week's Hot Dog Sunday, as well as the many who joined to share in the happiness of the event. It builds up that sense of community which witnesses to and makes present the love and goodness of the Lord. Thanks.


Back home By the time this column is published, I should be home from a five day visit and retreat at St. Anselm Abbey in New Hampshire. I always enjoy


renewing acquaintance with the monks and spending time doing spiritual reading and participating in the community Mass and prayers, and I try to time the visits to coincide with the Feast of St. Benedict.

<u>This week</u> we celebrate the Memorial of <u>St. Bonaven-ture</u>, <u>O.F.M.</u>, bishop and doctor of the Church, on July 15. He was born in 1221 and died in 1274. He

was an outstanding philosopher and theologian, educated at the University of Paris. Having entered the Franciscan order in 1243, he eventually became its Master General. He was appointed Archbishop of York in 1265, but never took up the post and resigned it a year later. He was subsequently appointed Cardinal Archbishop of Albano and died while attending the Second Council of Lyon. A legend says that he got the name Bonaventure from St. Francis who, seeing him in his infancy, exclaimed "O bona ventura!" "O good future!"
