# OUR LADY STAR OF THE SEA PARISH

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

“This is how it is with the Kingdom of God.” These words from today’s Gospel (see Mark 4:26-34) differ from the usual introduction to Jesus’ parables, an example of which we hear later in the same reading: “To what shall we compare the Kingdom of God...” “This is how it is.” What a great phrase! Jesus tells us, then, something about “how it is,” about life and about his own approach to the mission that was his in life so that we, too, might follow.

“It is as if a man were to scatter seed...” That is, in our ultimate relationship with God and in all our relationships with each other, we are like this man who scatters seed. Whether the man sleeps or rises, whether it be day or night does not matter as much as does the inner strengths of that which was sown: it grows towards its own fulfillment.

For us, each of our actions and, especially, all our words, are like that seed which has been scattered across life. Once it is out there, it takes on a life of its own. And, as the Second Reading reminds us (see 2 Corinthians 5:6-10), something “whether good or evil” will result in accord with what has been done, what has been said. The “mustard seed” from among all the seeds scattered by the man in question, though “the smallest of all the seeds of the earth,” actually results in “the largest of plants.” All this reminds us that our faithfulness in all things, great and small, each and every day, builds the dominant presence in our lives. “This is how it is.” Are you planting with Jesus for the growth of the Kingdom of God, or are you scattering the evil of unfulfilled promises and missed opportunities that grow into the chaos of this world that Jesus so much wants to heal, restore and raise up? He asks you to sow his Word, together with him, for the good of all.

We celebrate this weekend Fathers’ Day. We are thankful for the good our Fathers have been and have brought into our lives. We seek, too, God’s own blessing upon them, living and deceased. We pray that our Fathers be faithful in great things and in small, and offer their very best, especially through the power of their words, so that the best will grow strong in their children and in this world we all share.

Here in the Parish, we have been working to renew and to restore our two parish councils, both Pastoral and Financial. All of the many decisions that are enacted in our parish life are meant to be done in the context of shared perspective and experience through the discussions in our established councils. Priests, Deacon and Staff, together with other Parishioners evaluate, discuss and propose what is deemed to be helpful for the growth of our Parish and the effectiveness of our witness to Christ in our wider community. Members of the Pastoral Council will be describing their experience and inviting your participation by approving new members to the Council or even by offering your own service for such a call. Our Finance Council (for which I am in arrears with information and consultation) is also to be restored and renewed drawing on the expert experience of Parishioners for the good of us all.

A well-balanced and complete Catholic life always includes quiet prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. When was the last time you dropped by the Church during the week to spend some time in prayer before the Eucharist? It is open daily; you are always invited. Our minds and hearts need to spend time stretching, exploring, reflecting and being energized by the wonder and power of the Eucharist that Jesus left us as a gift of his abiding presence in our midst. If you are interested in promoting within our Parish community new opportunities for Eucharistic celebration, adoration and exposition please call or email the rectory with your name and best contact. I would like to assemble and work with a group to come up with a good proposal for Eucharistic Renewal in our midst.

**Catholic Update** There is a new "Update" for June and July. It is titled "The Mass Before and After Vatican II," and it says it is the first of two parts on the topic. The second part may be the August issue. This issue acknowledges that for many of us the changes to the Mass after Vatican II were very difficult to accept. It traces some of the developments which were taking place, especially among scholars, before the Council and looks at the questions of the use of the vernacular rather than Latin and permitting the laity to receive Communion from the chalice. You may find it interesting reading.

**Summer** will begin on Thursday, June 20, at 4:51 p.m., Boston Time. (For my brother in Japan that will be 5:51 a.m. on the 21st.) I'm looking forward to the hot weather: it's my favorite season. Summer is prime vacation and

While still a student at the Roman College, he died as a result of [disease he contracted while] caring for the victims of a serious epidemic. He was beatified in 1605 and canonized in 1726"
