June 9, 2024 Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

The Sunday readings we have for our prayer this weekend, the Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, often fall out of our regular yearly schedule. This year we had Six Sundays in Ordinary Time before Lent. The Seventh Sunday was suppressed for lack of sufficient Sundays remaining after Pentecost and before Advent. Ordinary Sundays Eight and Nine were replaced by Trinity Sunday and Corpus Domini respectively. This year we do, however, get to pray the Tenth.

During this year, we focus on the Gospel according to St. Mark. St. Mark highlights the authority and power Jesus demonstrates in his teachings and in his person. The expulsion of demons plays a prominent role in St. Mark's portrayal of Jesus. It raises, for us, the perennial question concerning the origin of evil in our human family and in our experiences of life. Certainly, the division and mutual accusation among groups in our country and the violence and wars facing our human family worldwide place the problem of evil very much before us.

The Book of Genesis (see Gn 3:9-15) affirms that God spoke a word of blessing (you may eat of all the trees in the Garden...) and a word of protection (but of the tree in the middle of the garden you shall not eat ...) When the word of protection was ignored, then the evil done interrupted human relationships right from the beginning and lead to the fear, blaming and shaming that are on display in today's First Reading. That same web of broken relationship with one another and with God is what underlies the strife and heartache of our world.

St. Paul (see 2 Cor 4:13-5:1), however, reminds us not to be "discouraged" but to look to the grace God bestows on us in the resurrection of Jesus, victor over sin and death. Jesus (see Mark 3:20-35) is the one who is stronger than evil. He it is who re-enacts the once broken word of protection by freely giving his life for the guilt of every mortal. In this, Jesus directly confronts and drives out evil and brings light to life, surpassing even the original word of unbounded blessing. He is the Son of the New Eve, Mary, with whom, in faith, Jesus is united in mind, heart, soul and love.

You and I, too, like Mary, and all of Jesus' followers, are called to "do the will of God" in communion of mind, heart, soul and love with Jesus. Only in Jesus is our inner self renewed day by day (see Second Reading) and is evil overcome by the power of the Word made flesh, the word of blessing and the word of protection, done as only God would do.

Here in the Parish, we have been working to renew and restore our two parish councils, both Pastoral and Financial. All of the many decisions that are enacted in our parish life are meant to be done in the context of shared perspective and experience through the discussions in our established councils. Members of the Pastoral Council will be describing their experience and inviting your participation by approving new members to the Council or even by offering your own service for such a call. Our Finance Council (for which I am in arrears with information and consultation) is also to be restored and renewed for the good of us all.

Comments from Deacon Joe

A Quiet Week



Town Election will be on Tuesday, June 11. It's a privilege of citizenship in a New England town to be able to to choose our local officials and a responsibility to vote wisely. If you're registered to vote, I encourage you to learn all you can about the candidates and to vote thoughtfully on Tuesday.

I didn't write the letter which appeared recently in the Marblehead Current in favor of a candidate for Select Board. It was signed by John Whipple. There is another John Whipple, the son of a late attorney, and I believe he is the writer. The letter stands on its own merits.

<u>Italian Food</u> As I mentioned a couple of weeks ago, the tour I went on in Italy had a major focus on food. We ate mostly food of the regions we visited. It be-



came clear that Emiglia-Romagna and Tuscany don't use a lot of tomato sauce, so it's not like what we generally think of in this country as Italian food.

For example, there's prosciutto and other pork products (including jowls), small ravioli-type pasta (tagliatelle) stuffed with things like swiss chard (erbetta), broths with small pasta, wild boar, osso buco, etc., but not much beef. Sauces were creamy and lightly applied. Rabbit appeared on menus, and one restaurant I ate at offered horse meat. I didn't

have any pizza, but I noticed that they generally didn't have the large variety of toppings we get here. Basically there was a very plain pizza with a bit of sauce and a bit of cheese, and there was pizza margherita with basil added to the plain pizza.


